Easy Hiking

Ounasvaara Recreational area

- Located only app. 3 km from city centre, reachable by foot
- Hiking tracks, biking tracks, campfire places and viewing tower
- Showcases the old forests, swamp areas and varying terrain of Lapland

Kuninkaan laavu – King's Lean-to

- Located app. 10 km from city centre
- One of the highest points in Rovaniemi, showcases the Lapland landscape with the round hills, river valley and rocky hill top

Unique nature spots in Rovaniemi

- **Auttiköngäs Nature Trails**
 - App. 1 hour drive from city centre
 - Trail runs across one of Finland's most spectacular waterfalls, through peaceful old-growth forest to a hilltop with views over Taiga forests
- **Devil's churns**
 - App. 30 min drive from city centre
 - There are 14 'devil's churns,' or potholes, three of these are counted among Finland's largest potholes
 - These potholes were created around 10,000 years ago
- **Käyräs Fell**
 - App. 1 hour drive from city centre
 - The fell in Rovaniemi area
