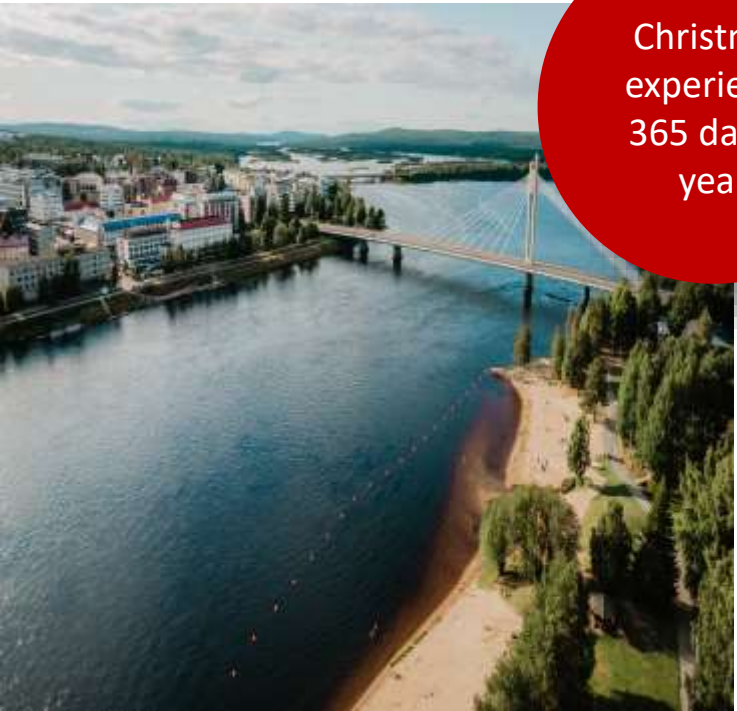

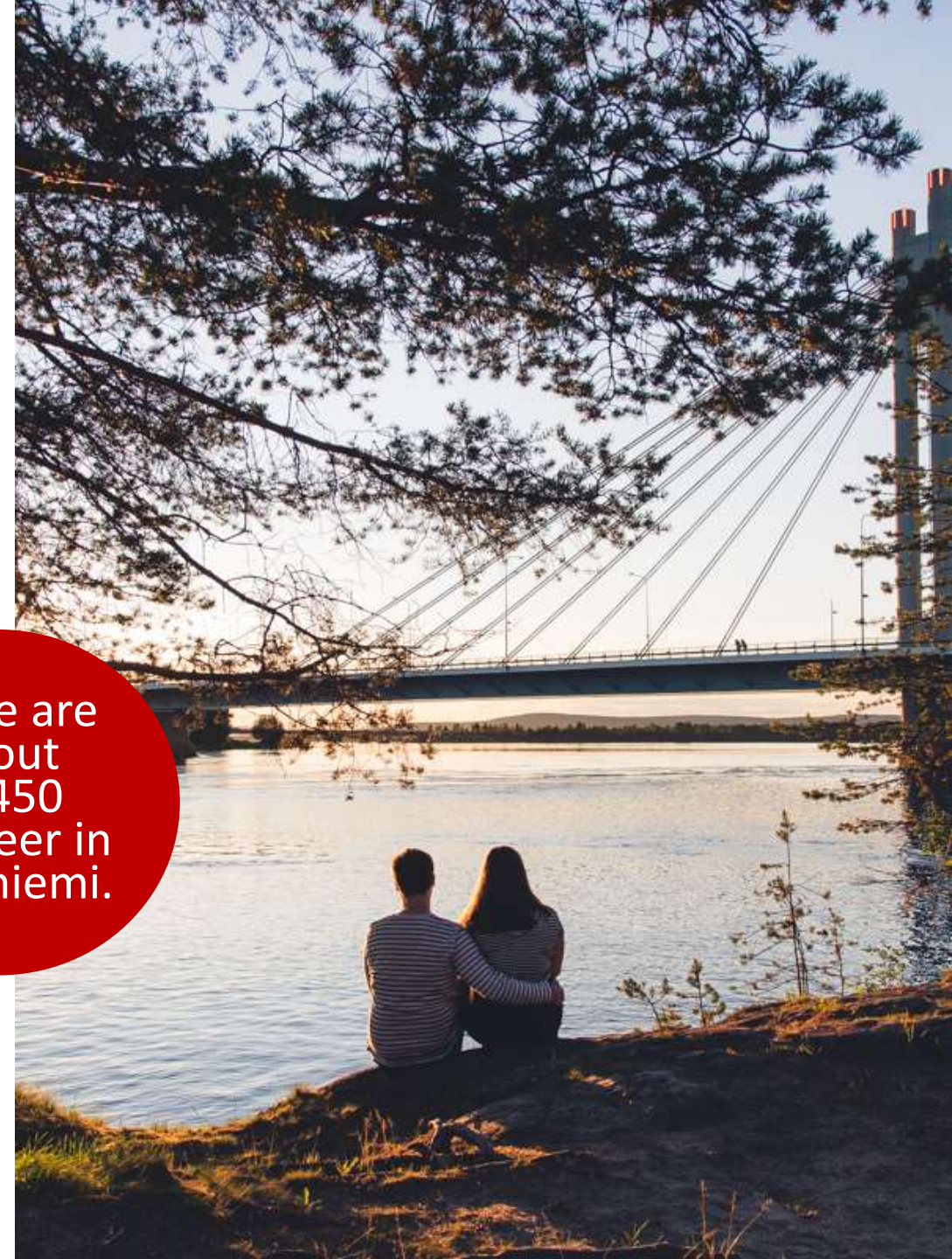




Facts about Rovaniemi

NOWADAYS

- Today Santa Claus Village is Finland's best-known attraction
- Year-round meeting point with Santa Claus
- Crossing the Arctic Circle, sending Post cards from Santa Claus' Main Post Office, meeting the reindeer, meeting the huskies , departing for tens of different activities, meeting Mrs Santa Claus in Mrs Santa Claus' Christmas Cottage and enjoying an outdoor Lappish lunch.
- It is home to approximately 50 attractions in the form of activity companies, shops, restaurants and cafés.

HISTORY

- Rovaniemi was almost destroyed in World War II. In 1950, Eleanor Roosevelt, the wife of US President Franklin D. Roosevelt, came to visit Rovaniemi to witness the rebuilding process on 11th June.
- She wanted to visit the Arctic Circle, and Rovaniemi officials rushed to building a cabin eight kilometers north of the city.
- The cabin marked the birth of Santa Claus Village and still stands today next to Santa Claus Main Post Office.

- Visible only on and above the Arctic Circle line
- Unique nature locations to spot the unique phenomenon close to city centre of Rovaniemi

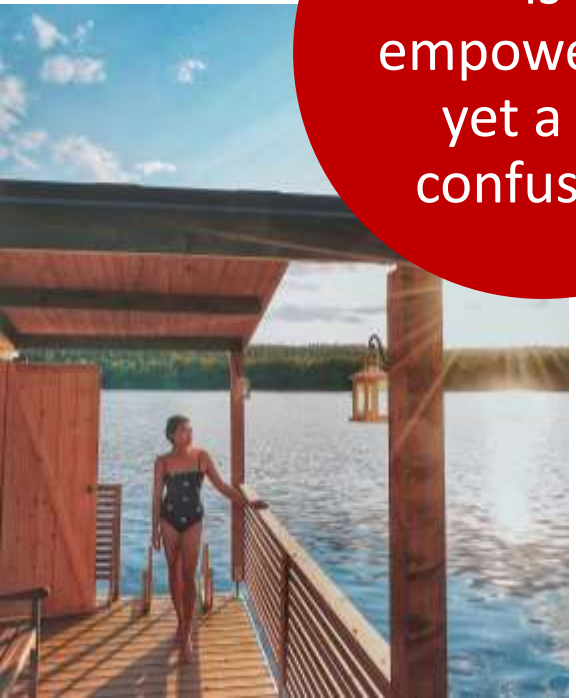

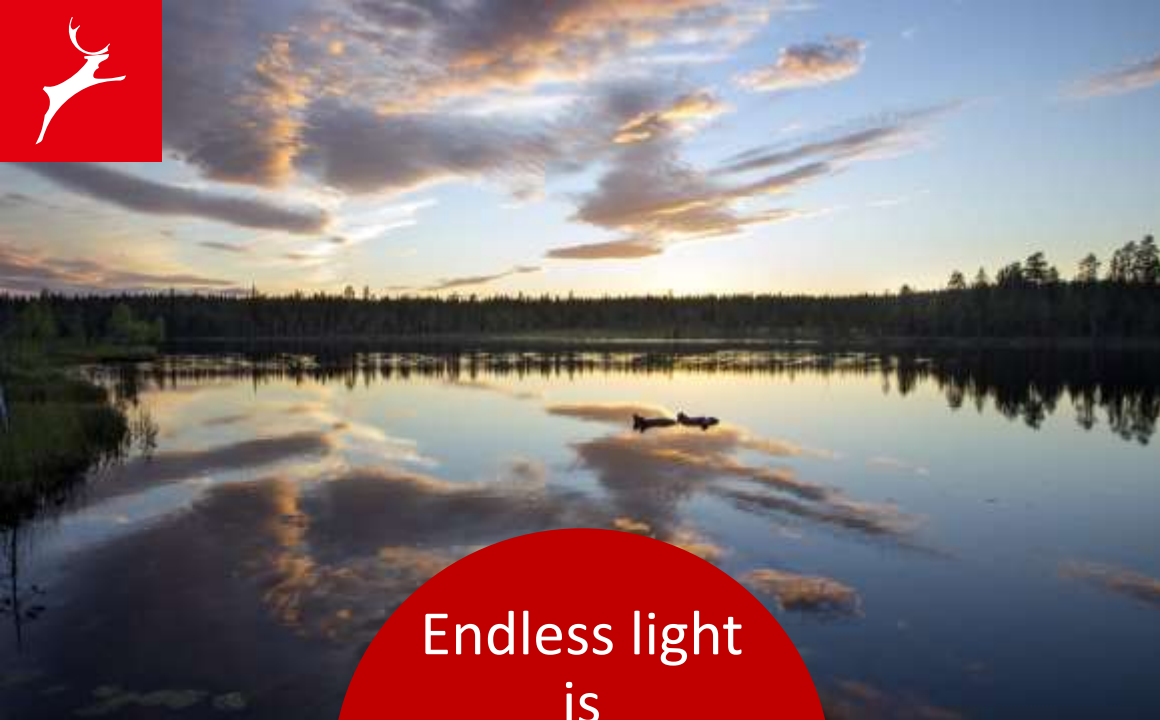

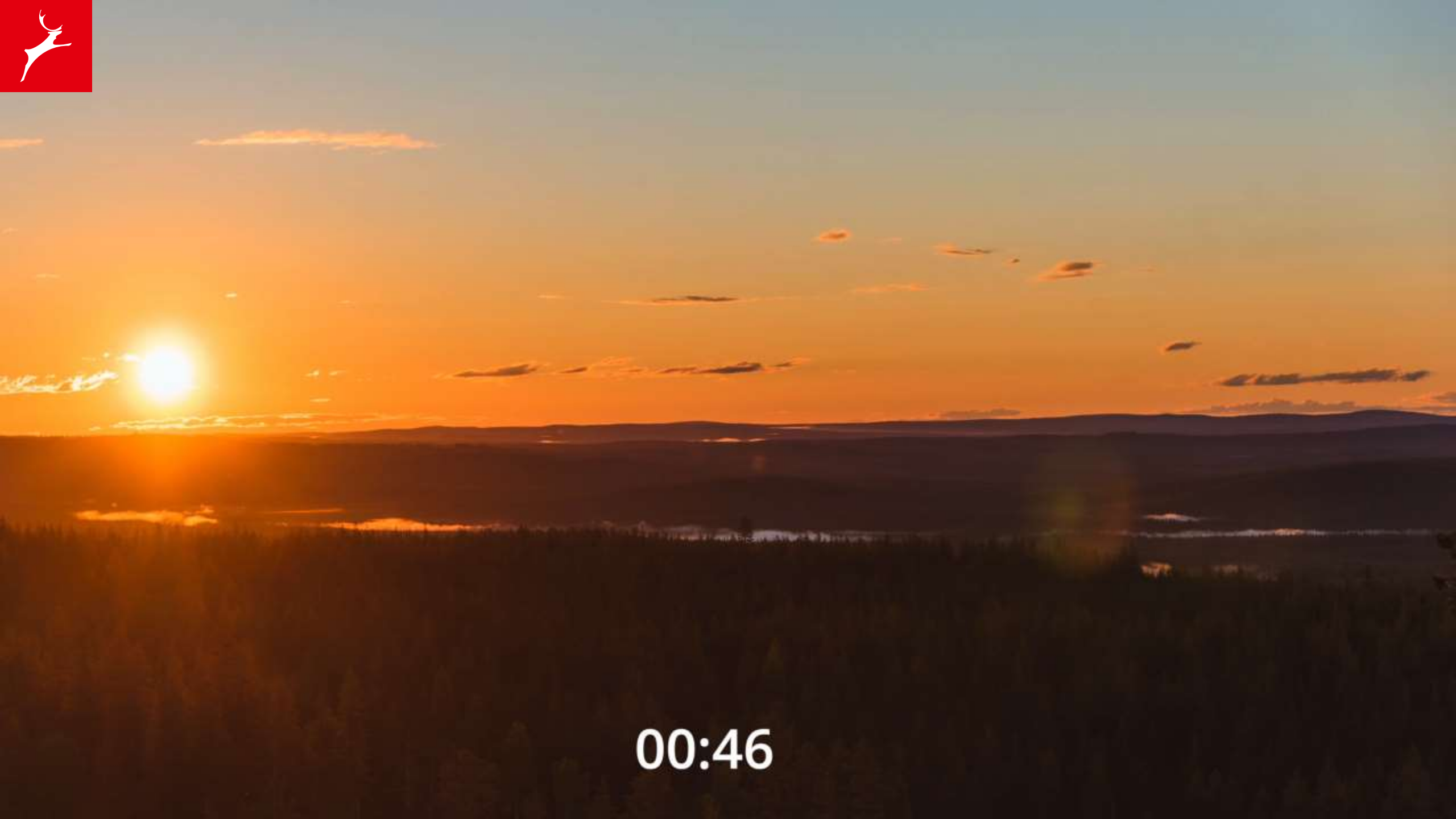
