HISTORY

- Rovaniemi was almost destroyed in World War II. In 1950, Eleanor Roosevelt, the wife of US President Franklin D. Roosevelt, came to visit Rovaniemi to witness the rebuilding process on 11th June.
- She wanted to visit the Arctic Circle, and Rovaniemi officials rushed to building a cabin eight kilometers north of the city.
- The cabin marked the birth of Santa Claus Village and still stands today next to Santa Claus Main Post Office.


